
Tickets are £15 each or £130 for a table of 10.

Carry on abroad

Planning a trip abroad this summer? The surgery provides advice and travel vaccines by our dedicated travel nurses. In order to be fully prepared, we ask that you contact us for an initial telephone appointment with one of our travel nurses to discuss your requirements and current level of vaccination cover. This appointment should be at least six weeks before you travel. The nurse will then outline what vaccines are needed, advise you of any costs, and book your appointments.

Respiratory reviews

It's still winter for a while longer and it's important to keep any respiratory condition under control. For patients with diagnosed asthma (using preventative inhalers), COPD, or any other respiratory condition, it is important that you attend your annual review which will be in the month of your birthday. Of course, if you are having trouble in-between reviews – please get in touch with reception and state you are having problems with your respiratory condition.

Our pharmacy team and local community pharmacies can help with inhaler technique and inhaler technical queries. It is very important to use your inhaler correctly to ensure you are getting the right dose of medication. Online access to your NHS record

If you don't already have access to view your medical record online, this has now been made even easier! You can simply download the NHS App to your smartphone and verify your identity using facial recognition and your passport or driving licence. You will need your NHS number - if you don't know this, please contact reception.

The NHS App will enable you to view your record from the date it is set up, book appointments, order prescriptions, and view test results. It also provides a 111 online service to check if you need urgent medical help.

If you require retrospective (historic) access to your medical record, this can be provided by returning a completed online access form to the surgery with a form of original photographic ID. You will then be sent an email providing your log-in and password to access SystmOnline.
